### Finding a reading mix with NoveList for free

Your Tulsa City-County Library card gives you free access to NoveList, the premier readers' advisory resource.

In this database, you can search among hundreds of thousands of popular fiction and readable non-fiction titles and retrieve author read-alikes, book lists, book discussion guides and more.

All editorial content is crafted by librarians and reading authorities who are experts in the field.

The Keeping Up pages deliver all you need (book lists, on-point articles, awards info and more) to quickly understand popular genres — and better pinpoint the books you'll love.

No matter what you are in the mood for reading, you can find it here complete with plot descriptions, appeal factors and professional reviews. Within each entry,

there is a direct link to the Tulsa City-County Library catalog; from there you can reserve a copy of the book.


The movie is *Hotel Transylvania*.

That's a home run, for Oklahoma. It's also the "power of power" at GRDA.


