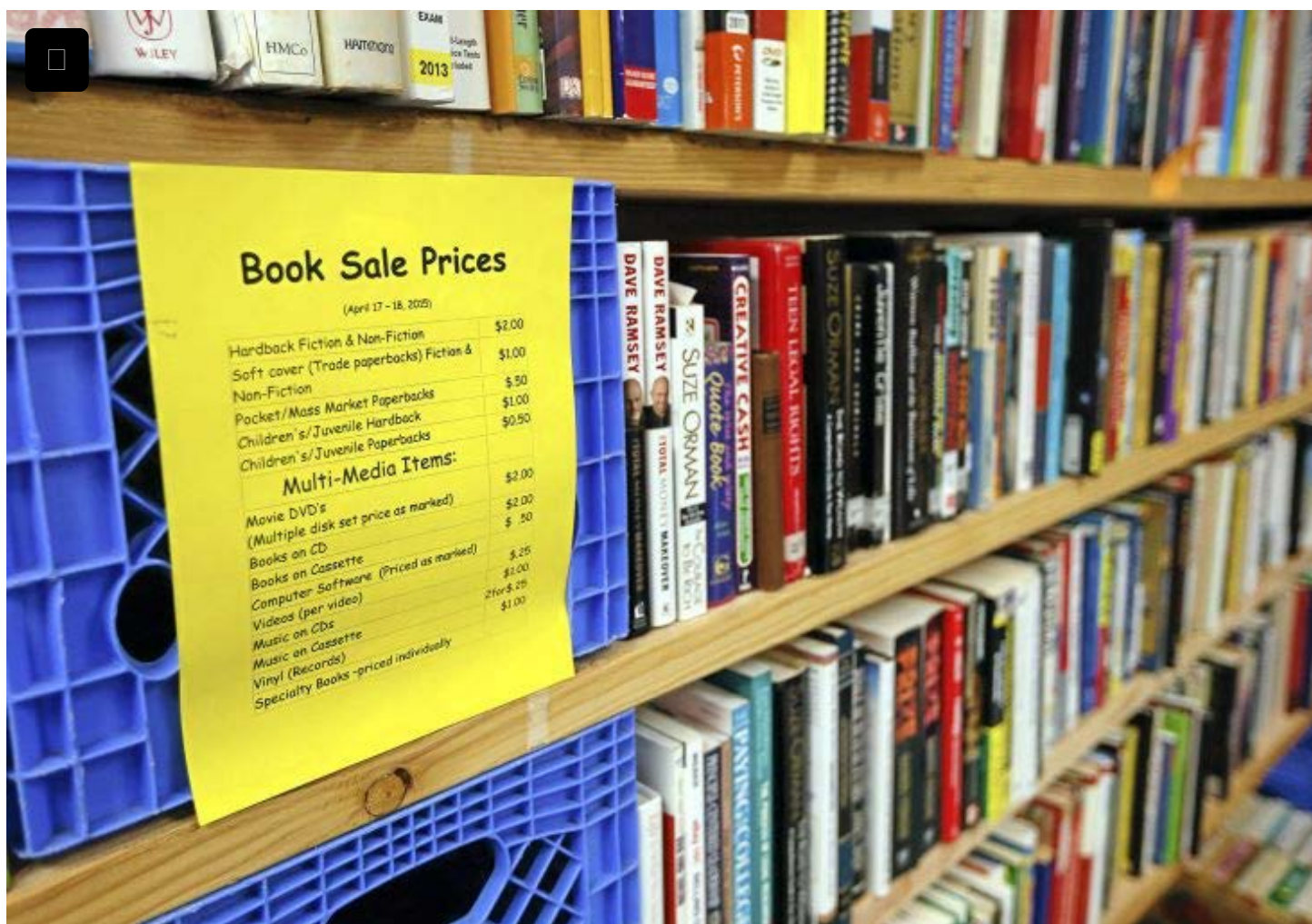

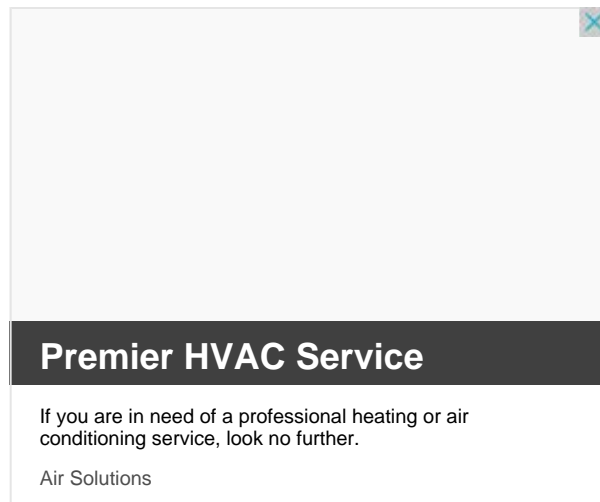


The Friends of the Helmerich Library book sale will take place Friday, April 21, and Saturday, April 22.
