## Compassion is Triologue topic

“The Struggle for Compassion” will be the title of the annual Oklahoma Center for Community and Justice’s 34th annual Triologue discussion series 2-4 p.m. on the first three Sundays of February.



The free public series is funded in part by the Tulsa Library Trust’s Alfred E. Aaronson Lecture Series Endowment. Sessions are:

- Sunday: “Compassionate Understanding,” Peace Academy, 4620 S. Irvington Ave. — How do we define compassion? What is Tulsa doing to become a more compassionate city? In a world full of nativism, division, fake news, clickbait headlines and 140-character messages, this session will unpack the need for compassionate understanding. Speakers: DeVon Douglass, Andrea Walker and Gary Peluso-Verdend.

- Feb. 12: “Compassionate Dialogue,” Antioch Baptist Church, 110 E. 56th St. North — Do you know your neighbor? Does your neighbor know you? This session asks community members to answer the question, “What is it like to live in Tulsa?” Speakers: Ashley Philippsen, Olympia Jones, Sean Moore and the Rev. Lizette Merchan Pinilla.

- Feb. 19: “Compassionate Action,” Jewish Federation of Tulsa, 2021 E. 71st St. — What would comprise a compassionate budget for the state of Oklahoma? What is your role in creating a more compassionate community? The session will examine tangible ways to make a compassionate difference. Speakers: David Blatt and Drew Diamond.
