Home Library Holds and Renewals

If you've ever found yourself with a looming due date and couldn't get to the library in time, you'll be happy to learn that you can renew your items online by logging into your account on the library's website.

To log in, first go to our home page, then click on the "My TCCL" tab on the red bar near the top of the page. First time users will need to create a username and follow the prompts for a small amount of additional info, such as birth date and email address, in

order to complete the setup.

While you are logged into your account, you can also place holds on library items. To place a hold, pull up the catalog page of the title you'd like, then click the green 'Place a Hold' button on the left side of the page.

Or, if you are looking at a list of search results, you can also place a hold on an item from the list by selecting the 'Place a Hold' option that appears on the right side of the item's title. In either case, you then will select a pickup location.
