The Seed Library: Start Your Spring Planting Today

Do you want to plant a vegetable garden? The Tulsa City-County Library now has a Seed Library to help you get started. The TCCL Seed Library is a collection of open-pollinated and heirloom seeds that you can borrow to plant and grow at home. It consists of seeds from a large variety of vegetables (and a few fruits and

flowers as well). Since, hopefully, the seeds will become plants, we don't expect you to bring those exact same seeds back. However, once the plant produces, you simply take a small portion of the vegetables, fruits or flower, harvest the seeds and dry them, and then return those to the library for other people.

All of our seeds are open-pollinated, and most are heirloom. We strive to foster locally adapted varieties, and by saving seeds, you make them even more locally adapted. Seed saving does take a little bit of know-how, but we try to make it simple for you. Seeds are ranked by ease of seed-saving, and we have lots of tips, links and books for you to learn more. You can borrow up to five seed packets per season.

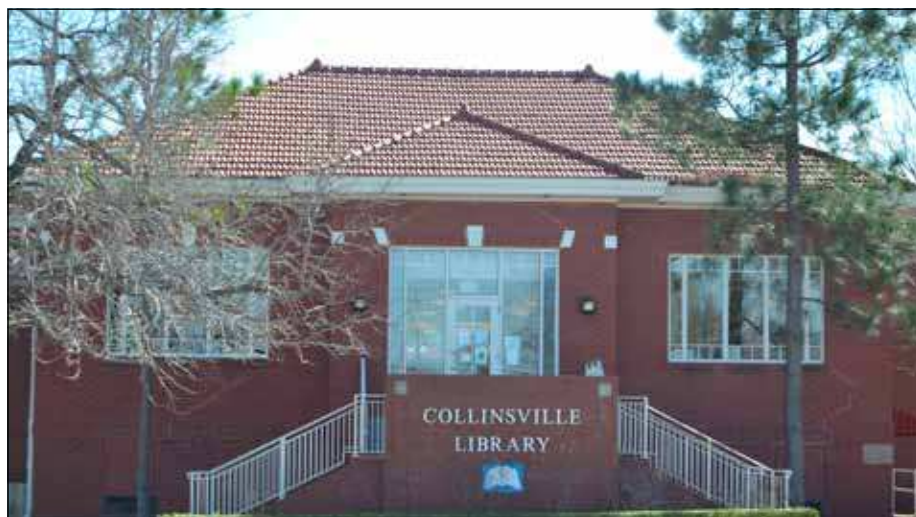
