Africa, Antarctica and India are some of the locales one may vicariously visit through "Travels with Tulsans," a series of illustrated talks sponsored by the Friends of the Tulsa City-County Library.

Speakers will share their experiences traveling around the world, using their photographs as illustrations.

The presentations will be at 12:10 p.m. Wednesdays at the Stovall Theater of the University Village Retirement Center, 8555 S. Lewis Ave. Admission is free.

The series begins Wednesday with "Paris to Spain with Teenagers," presented by Tulsa children's book author Stacy Nyikos.

On Jan. 27, Jan Reese will share an "East Africa Photo Safari" that trekked through Tanzania and Kenya, exploring the Seregenti, the Masai Mara and Ngorongoro Crater, as well as witnessing the migration of hundreds of thousands of wildebeest, gazelle and zebra.

The Feb. 10 session will be "India and Nepal in 1995," presented by Gary Mailes, journeying to one country that is among the most populous, the other home to the world's tallest mountains.

A 10-day trip aboard the French exhibition ship Le Boreal is the subject of the Feb. 17 lecture, "A Visit to Antarctica," presented by Oklahoma State University-Tulsa president Howard Barnett.

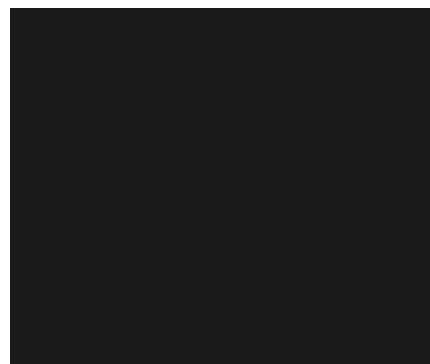
