At the front of that list is a handy text alert that can keep you abreast of everything you need to know around the library.

#### Sign up for Library Text Alerts

With library text alerts you can receive text messages when

- items you requested are ready for pickup
- items you have checked out are due soon
- items you have checked out are overdue

You can also send text messages to

- renew items you have checked out
- search for an item at the library using an ISBN

Texts are available in English & Spanish, and multiple accounts can be tracked from one phone number.

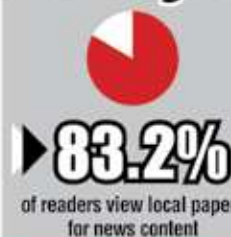
As much as people love Gobbles, they hate Doug Linken. When Linken is gunned down in his backyard it's good riddance, and the list of possible murder suspects is long.
