Derek Anderson, children's book author and illustrator, visited Skiatook Elementary November 12 to visit with Skiatook's 2nd graders and students from Hope Christian Academy.

Anderson made points to the kids that it's ok to not get it right the first time, or even the second time. It's ok to make mistakes. It's ok if your drawing doesn't look like everyone else's drawing. Anderson said, "If vou want something perfect, take a picture. If you want something unique that is yours, draw it."
