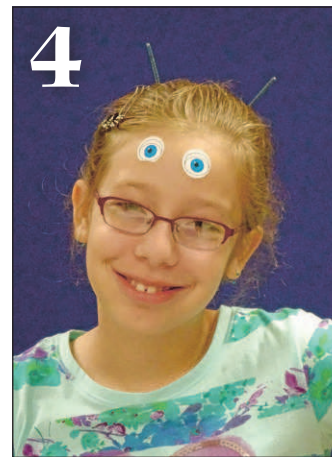
Space aliens invaded South Broken Arrow Library Saturday with giggles, cuteness and even some dancing.
