Marrs Elementary to hold Pre-K/Kindergarten Roundup on April 30

It is that time of year again. Marrs Elementary School, in Skiatook, will be holding its Pre-K/Kindergarten Roundup for new enrollees on Thursday, April 30, from 5:30 p.m. to 7 p.m.

If your child is currently enrolled in our Pre-K program, you will not need to attend.

Students must be the following ages for enrollment: Pre-K enrollees must be 4 years old by Sept. 1, 2015; Kindergarten enrollees must be 5 years old by Sept. 1, 2015.

Parents must be present and have (no exceptions):

- A current utility bill in their name (gas, electric, water);
- A certified birth certificate from the state, with the state seal;
- Current shot records for the student.

If applicable and/or

available, the following should be provided:

- Indian card for student;
 - Custody/guardian papers with court seal.
- Required immunizations for Pre-K: 4 DTP (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis), 3 OPV/IPV (Polio), 1 MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella),

3 Hepatitis B, 2 Hepatitis A, 1 Varicella (Chicken Pox).

Required immunizations for Kindergarten: 5 DTP (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis), 4 OPV/IPV (Polio), 2 MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella), 3 Hepatitis B, 2 Hepatitis A, 1 Varicella (Chicken Pox).

The Caring Van will be available the night of the roundup to administer shots. All shots must be received prior to enrollment. Incomplete enrollments will not be accepted, so therefore the student will not be placed in a class nor put on the Pre-K waiting list.
