New from the Tulsa City-County Library

Downloadable e-books and audiobooks

Every month in 2015 the Tulsa City-County Library will be featuring a library service.

This month's featured service is downloadable e-books and audiobooks. You can download free e-books and audiobooks to your tablet, computer or smart phone with a valid Tulsa City-County Li-

You can find these items on the library www.tulsalibrary.org/downloads or by searching the library cata-

The library has several ways to check out e-books and audiobooks:

Overdrive

Select from thousands of titles for use with a PC, Mac and a wide variety of mobile devices. In order to use Overdrive you need internet access, a compatible device (computer, e-reader, tablet, smart phone, etc.), free Overdrive software or you can read Overdrive books in your browser.

You can check out 10 e-books or audiobooks at a time and you can choose to keep them for either seven or 14 days.

The titles automatically expire from your device when the lending period expires or you can return them early and check out more.

There are no late fees and you can re-

download the OneClick Digital app to your computer, tablet, or smart phone. The app is very user-friendly.

ComicsPlus

Get immediate access to thousands of digital graphic novels, comic books and manga that are always available. No wait-

These items check out for seven days on your device and automatically expire. Find comics from many different publishers, including older comics like Archie and Charlie Brown.

Project Gutenberg

Select from more than 40,000 free public domain titles that never expire and don't count against your library checkout limit.

Freading

Freading offers more than 22,000 ebooks that are downloadable anytime, with no waiting lists. This service works a little differently from Overdrive.

Freading's e-books are checked out for two weeks at a time using a system of virtual "tokens." Every Sunday you are given 10 tokens which can be used to download e-books.

Each e-book costs one, two or four tokens depending on the release date of the title.

There is no need to return Freading items because there are no waiting lists. They automatically expire from your device and you can renew them if needed.

OneClick Digital

Download exclusive bestsellers and other popular titles previously unavailable in eAudio from major publishers. This service is only for audiobooks and eventually all audiobooks will be downloaded through OneClick Digital.

Currently you can still also download audiobooks from Overdrive. You can
