# Speaker to discuss Kristallnacht, which marked start of Holocaust

An author and former University of Tulsa professor now living in Cleveland, Ohio, will talk Sunday about Kristallnacht, the event that marked the beginning of the Holocaust in Europe.

Jay Geller, author of "Jews in Post-Holocaust Germany 1945-1953," will speak on "When the Synagogues Burned: Making Sense of Kristallnacht."

His free public lecture will be held at 2 p.m. Sunday in the Sylvan Auditorium of the Charles Schusterman Jewish Community Center, 2021 E. 71st St., sponsored by the Tulsa Council for Holocaust Education in partnership with the Tulsa City-County Library.

Geller is the Samuel Rosenthal Professor of Judaic Studies and associate professor of history at Case Western Reserve University.

He taught a wide variety of courses on European history and Jewish history at TU from 2002 to 2009, and he spoke often at the annual Yom Hashoah commemoration, at the Institute of Adult Jewish Studies, and at the Circle Cinema and Central Library.

He is writing a biography of a single German-Jewish family across two centuries.

Kristallnacht, also called the Night of Broken Glass, was a coordinated attack on Jewish businesses and synagogues across Nazi Germany and Poland on Nov. 9-10, 1938. More than 1,000 synagogues were burned,

along with 7,000 businesses.

At least 91 Jews were killed and 30,000 were arrested and thrown into concentration camps. Jewish schools, homes and hospitals also were attacked.

The event is considered the beginning of the Jewish Holocaust, which killed 6 million Jews during World War II.
