The Broken Arrow Genealogical Society will hold its quarterly business meeting Tuesday, July 8 at 7 p.m. in the third floor meeting room of the Broken Arrow Historical Museum.

Teresa Runnels, coordinator of the American Indian Resource Center at Zarrow Regional Library, will present a program on the holdings available for study.

Unlike genealogy sources, the center has music, books, DVDs and other material relative to the history of the American Indian.

Tulsa's center is one of two American Indian resource centers in the United States. Runnels was put in charge nine years ago. Since then the collection has tripled and moved from Tulsa Central Library to Zarrow Regional Library.

Runnels was recently honored for her efforts by being named to the 2014 list of Library Journal's Movers and Shakers, one of 50 persons recognized as emerging library leaders from across the world.
