Saturday-Sunday: Master Gardeners garden tour

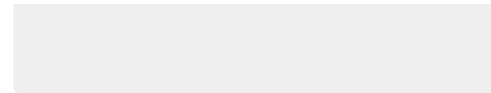

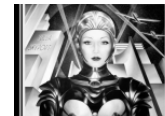
