\$90,000 of bonds to pay for student transportation improvements.

The total amount is \$350,000. You can also read more about the Avant Public Schools bond election at the school district's website, www.avant.k12.ok.us.

Tulsa County voters will be asked April 1 to decide on two sales-tax propositions. The overall sales tax increase in portions of

Tulsa County outside the city of Tulsa will be .067 percent over 15 years if both propositions are approved.

The first proposition concerns a proposal to add .041 percent of sales tax to pay for the construction of a new juvenile justice center.

The second proposition concerns a proposal to add .026 percent of sales tax to finance the construction and staffing of new space at the David L. Moss Criminal Jus-

tice Center, which is the county jail. A portion of the new space would be set aside for inmates with mental health problems.

The sales tax in the Tulsa County portion of Skiatook would increase by .067 percent as of July 1 if the measures are approved.

According to the Tulsa County Election Board, the polling place for the Tulsa County portion of Skiatook on April 1 will be Immanuel Baptist Church.

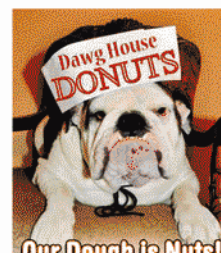
