These fees are in addition to the amount paid to the treasurer. Neither the Tulsa County Treasurer nor Tulsa County receives any portion of the convenience fees. Credit card and electronic check payments, CANNOT be accepted at the Treasurer's Office or our remote bank locations. They may only be processed by internet or phone.
