For kindergarten through fifth grade. Stay for a great story, snacks, activities and crafts.

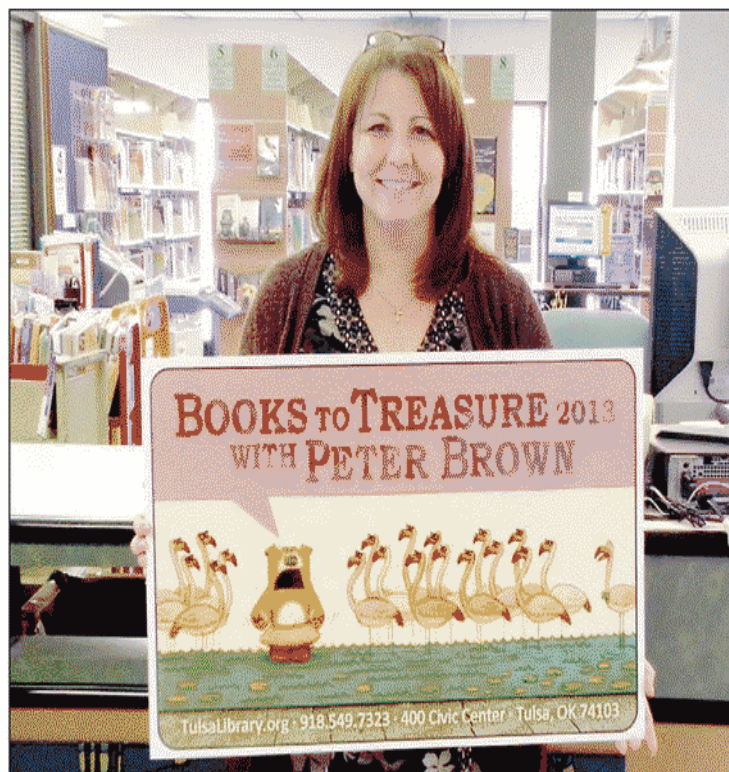
- SWAP (Skiatook Writers and Poets) — Second Tuesday of each month, 4-5 p.m.
