

Oklahoma Sales Tax Permit

ANY Oklahoma-based businesses or foreign company operating in the state must register for a sales tax permit. This applies to businesses with a physical presence in the state like a storefront or warehouse, as well as online businesses and phone or mail-order companies.



How to Register for an Oklahoma Sales Tax Permit

Can apply online via the Oklahoma Tax Commission's Online Taxpayer Access Point

Will need to provide basic information about the business

• Will need to select the filing frequency (determines how often you are required to submit sales tax returns and remit any tax due for sales tax returns – Monthly, Quarterly, or Annually based on the amount of sales tax you expect to.



How to Register for an Oklahoma Sales Tax Permit

- There is a \$20 fee to register
- A separate Oklahoma sales tax permit is required for each location you operation.
- When you collect you will need to pay tax to the state

(BAR, OMMA, Food/Food Truck related businesses)





Do I need to pay sales tax?

SALES TAX
A TAX CHARGED AND COLLECTED ON THE STATE, COUNTY AND CITY LEVEL (WHERE APPLICABLE) ON ALL TRANSFERS OF TITLE OR POSSESSION OF TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY AND CERTAIN SERVICES THAT OCCUR WITHIN THIS STATE.









Charge, collect and remit state, county and city sales taxes.



REMOTE SELLERS

Sellers who do not maintain a place of business in Oklahoma



Must send an annual statement to their Oklahoma customers by February 1 notifying them of the amount of their total purchases made during the previous calendar year.



17-page application


6-8 weeks for processing and approval






Allowing residents to shape the future of the communities in which they live. (Kirkpatrick Heights Greenwood Materplan, Fair Oaks developments)


